- African immigrant (AI) communities face barriers to accessing hepatitis B screening, vaccination and linkage to care
- CDC collaborated with Hepatitis B Foundation to respond to these needs

# **The Process**

### Phase I: Gather Data

- Literature Review
- Creation of an advisory board
- Qualitative study
  - 13 individual interviews
  - 2 focus groups
  - One in-person meeting

#### Phase II: Create Educational Materials

- Pilot test materials
- Finalize materials

- Training for community health workers (PowerPoint file)
- Flipchart for use with the community
